We welcome you to be a part of the 'Deadly Heart Trek' to help end rheumatic heart disease (RHD)

What is rheumatic heart disease (RHD)?

RHD is a preventable disease but if it's not diagnosed or treated, it can cause heart failure, disability and even death. It starts with a sore throat or skin sore caused by Strep A bacteria and can permanently damage the heart.

What's this Trek all about?

We want to listen, learn and respond to the needs of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Communities on RHD. So a group of experienced doctors, local health workers and Aboriginal leaders are **going to Western Australia to a few communities**. This Trek is in consultation with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Communities, local health services, local land councils and other local organisations. This is not a medical research program, this is a team of dedicated health professionals and Aboriginal people who have Community interest at the core of their work. It is up to your Community if you would like to participate and we will only visit if you have asked to take part.

The team will offer education on RHD and where requested, identify and treat those affected by RHD.

Why?

Together with your help, we will raise awareness and understanding of this disease within Community and beyond. We will empower Aboriginal leadership and self-determination. We will demonstrate that RHD needs political action and commitment for diagnosis, treatment and prevention.

Who is involved?

Communities take the lead, by inviting the Trek teams to visit.

The teams on the ground are led by First Nations cultural guides, doctors, health workers and nurses, working closely with community leaders. Many team members are known to the communities as they have worked for decades on RHD. The Snow Foundation provides funding and project management, a philanthropic organisation with a long history of supporting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

How can we take part?

You can decide if you'd like to participate and the support you need. We may not be able to meet all of your requests due to limited timing but the information will be helpful to provide to your local Council so they are aware of your needs.
